



Christophe GOLAY

Christophe Golay holds a PhD in International Relations (specializing in International Law) from the Graduate Institute of International and Development Studies. He wrote his doctoral thesis on *The right to food and access to justice*. He also holds an MA in international law and a degree in international relations from the Graduate Institute of International Studies. He represented the Graduate Institute in the J. Pictet International Humanitarian Law Competition several times during his studies, as a participant then as a coach.

From 2001 to July 2008, Christophe was a member and then the Coordinator of the Research Unit on the Right to Food, based at the Graduate Institute of Development Studies, supporting the mandate of the United Nations Special Rapporteur on the right to food, Prof. Jean Ziegler. He participated in the drafting of all reports of the Special Rapporteur between November 2001 and April 2008 and has participated in several missions with the United Nations, including to Niger, Ethiopia, India, Bangladesh, Brazil, Bolivia, Guatemala, Cuba and the Occupied Palestinian Territories. He participated in numerous conferences and several international negotiations, including the FAO guidelines on the right to food and the Optional Protocol to the International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights. Dr. Christophe Golay has been teaching a course on theory and practice of economic, social and cultural rights since 2002 to the students of the Masters in International Development Studies (IMAS) at the Graduate Institute. In 2008 and 2009, he taught an Executive Education Training Course to professionals working in ESC rights, including advocates, researchers, and field workers, on monitoring economic, social and cultural rights. In September 2009, he will begin teaching a course on economic, social and cultural rights and development to the students of the Master on Development Studies of the Institute. He teaches regularly at the Faculty of Law at the University of Fribourg and the University of Grenoble, at the Faculty of Medicine at the University of Geneva, the Interdisciplinary Program in Humanitarian Action, the International Service for Human Rights and the College Henri Dunant. He is external member of the Council of the Interdisciplinary Institute for Ethics and Human Rights at the University of Fribourg.

Christophe Golay has been a Senior Researcher at the Geneva Academy of International Humanitarian Law and Human Rights since August 2008, where he jointly coordinates the Project on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights, along with Claire Mahon.
