Sharon Weill is a PhD student in International Humanitarian Law (IHL) at the University of Geneva. She is doing her PhD on the application of IHL by national courts under the supervision of Prof. Sassoli, and working for the RULAC project as a research assistant.

She graduated from CUDIH in 2006. Her master thesis included a field research in Israeli military courts in the Palestinian Occupied Territories.

She also holds a Masters Degree in Human Rights and Democratization from the University of Malta (Mediterranean master, Euro-Med programme) and a B.A in Laws from Tel Aviv University.

Following the experience of the Mediterranean HR master, she wrote and developed, with an Italian colleague, a documentary film project “Borders”, which was financed by the European Commission. The film is a road movie in the Mediterranean region, dealing with borders and conflicts. She regularly presents her film as a part of a seminar on HR and conflicts in different universities in Europe and elsewhere.
